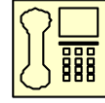

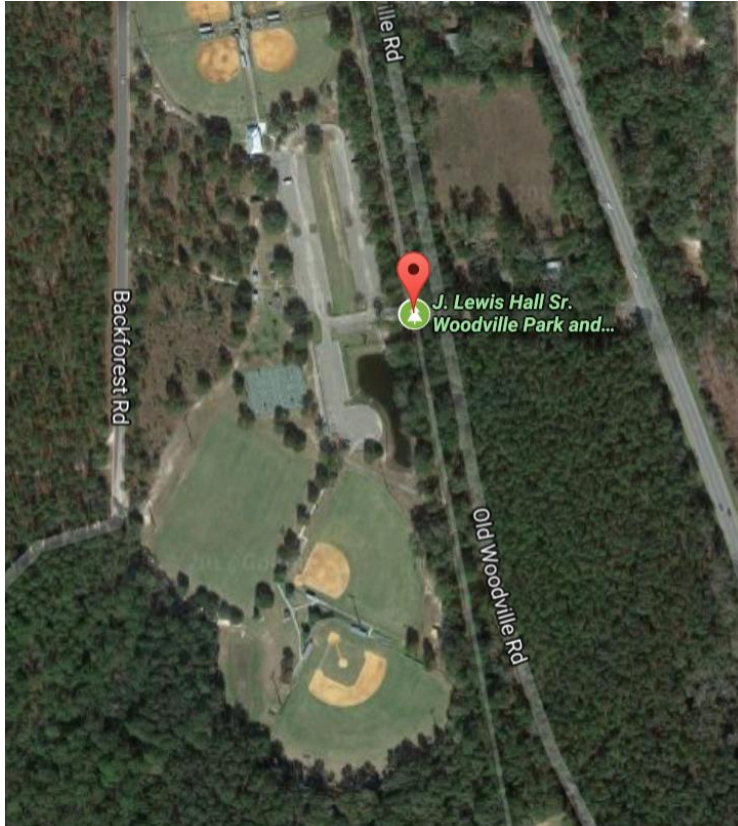
Fred George Park

This new park is in its second year of service. It's a very nice facility that includes a playground, multipurpose field, baseball field, and beautiful walking trails. Address is **4830 Fred George Rd, Tallahassee, FL 32303**. *Note that when viewing the satellite image of this address it shows a clump of trees. Online mapping systems are not yet up-to-date with current images.*



Woodville Park

Another scenic park with lots of features to keep anyone of any age engaged in the outdoors. This is one of the oldest parks in service from our local Leon County Parks and Recreation (LCPR) department. Notable features include a playground, multipurpose field, baseball fields, basketball courts, miles of mountain bike trails, and a 16 mile paved trail for biking, walking, roller blading, etc. The best address to locate the entrance is **7603 Woodville Hwy, Tallahassee, FL 32305**. The actual listed address for this park is 1398 Back Forest Road, Tallahassee, FL 32305 but to locate it from the main road can be tricky.

General Information / Helpful Hints

1. **There will be a MANDATORY Team Manager Meeting on Friday, July 14, 2017 at 1:00pm (ET) at Fred George Park.** At this meeting the tournament format, schedule, and rules will be discussed. If you have any questions about this tournament get them asked and answered at this meeting. Coin toss for Home/Visitor will be held during this meeting.
2. The following will be reviewed at the above meeting or before your first game
 - Team Affidavits and supporting paperwork
 - Medical Release Forms
3. Games will be played in accordance with Tournament Rules
4. Umpires will check all equipment prior to each game – faulty equipment will be removed and will not be allowed to be used.
5. Pitching Affidavits will be filled out completely following each game. The Manager is responsible to assure the Affidavits are accurate.
6. Teams should arrive at least one (1) hour prior to the scheduled game start time.
7. Team Warm-Up areas are provided. No hitting balls against the fences.
8. Teams must pick up trash in dugout before vacating.
9. **NO COOLERS** are allowed inside the park (with the exception that the team may have a cooler in the dugout with drinks, wet towels, etc).
10. The use of tobacco and alcohol are strictly prohibited. Smoking is allowed only in the designated areas – No Exceptions.
11. Obscene language or harassment by anyone will not be tolerated. Offenders will be ejected from the park.

12. Use of batting cages and pitching cages are allowed if resource is available at field and approved by tournament director.
13. Lineup cards must be in the format, "LAST NAME, First Initial" (i.e. SMITH, J), and must include player uniform number and starting positions.
14. Soft toss into a popup net is permitted. Net must be used in the designated warm up area and batted balls must in a direction not facing pedestrian traffic. Batters must wear helmets.
15. Soft toss without a popup net is permitted but is restricted to plastic whiffle balls or equivalent. See the tournament director for approval prior to soft toss event. Batters must wear helmets.
16. As a reminder:
 - a. No adult may warm up a pitcher.
 - b. Player catchers warming up pitchers must wear a catcher's mask with dangling throat guard.
 - c. Managers and coaches must wear closed toe shoes and are not permitted to wear cleats.
17. The TEAM ROSTER CARD form at the end of this document should be filled out and brought to the Managers/Coaches meeting. This form will be used to announce players and coaches for opening and closing ceremonies.
